



## AAEE Awards Emeritus Member Award

Emeritus membership honors AAEE members who have retired from educational career planning and placement or school personnel administration. Nominees must have given meritorious service to and be recognized as professional contributors to the professional activities of AAEE, as well as to state and regional educational career planning and placement or personnel administration organizations. Individuals are welcome and encouraged to nominate themselves for this award. Nominees must meet at least five of the following seven criteria:

- ▲ Membership in AAEE for a minimum of 15 years.
- ▲ Service as an officer of AAEE.
- ▲ Service on the AAEE Executive Committee or Board of Directors.
- ▲ Service as an officer of an AAEE-related state or regional association.
- ▲ Service as an officer of a state, regional or national educator's association.
- ▲ Leadership in AAEE activities (e.g., conference planning, chairing or serving on committees, developing publications, leading task forces).
- ▲ Leadership in research or professional growth projects, or authorship of articles for AAEE publications.
